4. DAMAGE TO DRAINS AND ABLUTION STANDS. (para 225 2 NZ Div ROs dated 17 June 43 is repeated)

Since the Div has arrived in Maadi Camp severe damage had been done to drains and ablutions stands. This has been caused mainly by careless driving, and the position is now so serious that the Garrison Engineer cannot possibly cope with all the repairs required. Units will ensure that in future more care is taken by drivers in this respect.

5. LOSS OF PAYBOOKS.

In spite of warnings ABs 64 continue to be lost in increasing numbers, in many cases due to carelessness or misconduct.

The danger of pick pockets is again stressed.

All ranks are reminded that money may NOT be carried in paybooks, and that loss of pay books involves the "freezing" of any credit balance.

6. MUSTER PARADE. A full muster parade of all ranks will be held tomorrow at 0830 hrs on Bn Parade ground. Coy markers will report RSM 0820 hrs. Coys march on 0825 hrs.
