1. ROUTINE:-

In future Headquarters Coy. will take a DOUBLE TOUR as Duty Coy in rotation with Rifle Coys.

2. CHURCH PARADES. SUNDAY 22nd. MARCH. 42.

C of B's will parade for church at 1000 hrs. outside the Y.M.C.A. R.C's parade will be at 19th Battalion. Transport Lines at the foot of Spiral at 1030 hrs.

3. DISCIPLINE:-

Troops last night broke bounds and entered ARSAL VILLAGE and caused trouble. Any soldier found there in future will be arrested and placed under guard. Coy Sentries will be on the alert at night and will FIRE on Natives in their area who do not halt when ordered.

4. ACCOMODATION - HOTELS, PENSIONS, etc.

(1) It is forbidden to all ranks to obtain accomodation in Hotels and Pensions other than in those appearing in the "approved" list.

(2) A list of the "approved" Hotels and Pensions will be kept by the Provost Branch and all Camp Commandants in the Cairo, Alexandria and Canal Areas.

(3) Permission to reside in any but the "approved" Hotels and Pensions must be obtained from the Provost Branch.

(4) Military personnel who are at present residing, or who in future intend to reside, with private families other than as guests of resident members of H.M Forces or in Hotels and Pensions not appearing on the "approved" list, will submit full particulars of their residence to the Provost Branch.

(5) Disciplinary action will be taken against all ranks not complying with this order.

5. DISCIPLINE - IDENTITY CARDS

Reference 2 NZMF Orders 524 and 537 of 1931 the following procedure will be carried out by Officers newly arrived in the serving Middle East, Officers commissioned from the ranks while in the Middle East and Officers who have lost their Identity Cards when making application for the issue of an Identity Card.

(1) The standard application form (see appendix "A" attached) will be filled (in duplicate) and THREE photographs will be obtained.

(2) One form, together with two photographs, duly attested by the OC Unit that they are certified true likeness of the applicant, will be forwarded through the usual channels to the Permit Office, BAB el RAHED, CAIRO, by Express Mail.

(3) The duplicate form with third form attached will operate as a temporary pass. It will bear a certificate by the applicant's OC to the effect that the original has been forwarded and will be valid for a period of 15 days.

All Officers are reminded that in the event of an Identity Card being lost there will be a charge of P 5 for replacement.

6. DISCIPLINE - GAMBLING

Instances have been recently noticed in which soldiers have congregated in various areas of CAIRO for the purpose of Gambling. As a result civilians have been caused annoyance and inconvenience and disturbances have arisen requiring the intervention of Military Police.

In future when soldiers are found congregated in public or semi-public places for the purpose of gambling they will be apprehended and charged under A.A Section 40.
