5. IINE PICQUET. Owing to the prevalency oi pilforing and theft from lines - Coy Comdrs will detail Picquets (dey and ni ght) for the proteotion of their lines and equipment.
6. TRANSPORT. It is essentiel thet the use of WD tpt to kept to an absolute minimum.
Work Tickets. No vehicles will leave MAADI Camp without the driver being in possescien af a warlk ticket signed by an offr. Movementy Orders. No vehicle other then flagged steff eers (i.e. cars of Offrs of the rank of Brizadier and abovs) will proceed outside CAIRO area without bein in possession of a movement order signed by AA \& QUKG 2 NZ Div. Check posts at exits to CAIRO will NOT Allow eny vehicles to pass unless suoh movement order is presented.

USE OF VEHICLES ON RTRANEXTE.
(a) Officerg. Fozmation and Unit Comde mey authorise the use of WD vohs for the purpose of oonveying ciffs on looal leave to $H A D I$ and CAIFiv at the following charges:MADI Camp to CAIRO - PI. 5 per Oifr. :innimum of three oifirs.
MAADI Camp to MAADI - PI $14 / 2$ per Oifr. IHinimum of three Offrs.
The above charges are ior single trips only.
(b) Other Ranks. Unit three ton lorries nay be used for the purpose of transporting personnel on looal leave to CAIRO. 30 other ranks will be carried in each $\$$ ton lorry. The charge for each 3 ton lorry used will be PT 75 for each return journey.
(o) The use of WD tpt for leave purposes is a veluable privilege and eny abuse whatever will lead to the immediate cancellation permission for tot to be used for this purpose.
8. THAVs. It is stressed thet every effort has been made to ensure that the maximum leave is onjoyed by all ranks and that as far as possible the minimum reatiictions hage been placed on the oonditions of leave. The generous facilities available for leave are a privilege and tps should ensure that their oonduct on leave is such that those privileges are not ourtailed.
Local Leaved Leave will bo grented from 1300 hrs until 0130 hrs daily to $15 \%$ of Unit atrength.
