1. ORDERLY DUTIES FOR 2 JUNE 43.

2. ROUTINE.

Reveille	0600 hrs

3. 5 NZ INF BDE MEMORIAL SERVICE.

- (a) At 0900 hrs in area in front of Officers quarters.
- (b) 28 NZ Bn marker will report to RSM 21 NZ Bn at 0830 hrs.
- (c) 28 NZ Bn will march on to marker so as to be in position by 0840 hrs.
- (d) Dress: Shirts KD, shorts, hoesetops, puttees, clean boots, belt and sidearms.
- (e) RCs may NOT parade for this service but will parade behind the 28 NZ Bn Officer's quarters under Major Roach, 21 NZ Bn and will march on to parade ground after the service.  
Dress for RCs same as for main parade.

4. RC SERVICE ASCENSION DAY will be held Thurs 3 June 43 in SHAFROS Theatre at 0830 hrs.

Offr i/c - Capt J Matchaere.

RCs parade 28 NZ Bn area 0805 hrs under Sjt H Takarangi and move off at 0815 hrs.

Dress as for 5 NZ Inf Bde Memorial Church parade. (Less belt and side arms).

5. LINE PICQUET. Owing to the prevalency of pilfering and theft from lines - Coy Comdrs will detail Picquets (day and night) for the protection of their lines and equipment.

6. TRANSPORT. It is essential that the use of WD tpt be kept to an absolute minimum.

Work Tickets. No vehicles will leave MAADI Camp without the driver being in possession of a work ticket signed by an Offr.

Movement Orders. NO vehicle other than flagged staff cars (i.e. cars of Offrs of the rank of Brigadier and above) will proceed outside CAIRO area without being in possession of a movement order signed by AA & QMG 2 NZ Div. Check posts at exits to CAIRO will NOT allow any vehicles to pass unless such movement order is presented.

73 USE OF VEHICLES ON REPAYMENT.

- (a) Officers. Formation and Unit Comds may authorise the use of WD vehs for the purpose of conveying Offrs on local leave to MAADI and CAIRO at the following charges:-

The above charges are for single trips only.

- (b) Other Ranks. Unit three ton lorries may be used for the purpose of transporting personnel on local leave to CAIRO. 30 other ranks will be carried in each 3 ton lorry. The charge for each 3 ton lorry used will be PT 75 for each return journey.
- (c) The use of WD tpt for leave purposes is a valuable privilege and any abuse whatever will lead to the immediate cancellation of permission for tpt to be used for this purpose.

8. LEAVE. It is stressed that every effort has been made to ensure that the maximum leave is enjoyed by all ranks and that as far as possible the minimum restrictions have been placed on the conditions of leave. The generous facilities available for leave are a privilege and tps should ensure that their conduct on leave is such that these privileges are not curtailed.

Local Leave/ Leave will be granted from 1300 hrs until 0130 hrs daily to 15 % of Unit strength.

To avoid congestion on roads and at debussing point, tpt will depart MAADI and CAIRO as follows:-

It is essential that these times are strictly adhered to as any congestion in CAIRO may lead to prohibition of the use of WD tpt for this purpose.

Dress for leave will be:-

- (b) Shirts Bush KD or shirts KD, Shorts KD or trousers KD, hats felt or Caps FS.
