RETURN OF LUGER PISTOLS (Repeated from pare 179 2 NZ Div ROs)

Officers of the 28 NZ(Meori) Bn holding 9 mm Luger pistols on charge will hand these into any 1800 hrs 20 June 43. ROM will hand these into 2 NZ Ordin Ord Fa Park by 21 June 43 and will draw from 2 NZ Div Fd Ord Fk standard .38 pistol in exchange.

There is veryspecial reason for the recall of those weapon and Officers will take steps to ensure that every available Luger pistol is returned.
