3. BDE C of B SERVICE.

- (a) At 0830 hrs Sunday 13 June 43 Bishop G.V. GERARD will officiate.

5. POSTAL AIRMAIL LETTER CARDS. (Para 296 2 NZEE Orders is repeated)

It is notified that the special airmail letter card printed and issued by the NZ YMCA may only be used for despatch by Air Service to New Zealand. The letter cards may NOT be used for despatch by air to the United Kingdom; South Africa, Australia or any other country. Any of the special YMCA letter cards received by the Army Postal Services pre-paid for despatch by air to any country, other than NZ will be sent forward to destination by surface means. Letter cards not pre-paid for air despatch, for NZ will of course be sent by surface means also.

6. LEAVE DAILY.

ADDENDUM TO LEAVE INSTRUCTION DATED 4.6.43 delete all reference to paras 3 and 4 in view of following:-

- (a) As from tomorrow 12 June, Coys will submit to Bn HQ a nominal roll of all leave personnel for that day.
- (b) This/roll will Bn HQ NOT later than 1100 hrs daily. Any rolls submitted later than this hour will not be considered.
- (c) Sum of 2 1/2 PT will be collected from each many <sup>total</sup> nominal rolls collected to be handed into Bn HQ with nominal rolls.
- (d) On return from leave, leave passes will be handed in to Coy Orderly Room NOT to Bn HQ.
