NZ FORCES CLUB-CAIRO.

- (a) Some months ago, to prevent overcrowding, NZ Forces Club was closed to troops other than New Zealanders. NZ troops were each entitled to invite a guest into the Club. This restriction has resulted in a very much improved service for NZ troops and it is intended to continue on these lines.
- (b) The position is now arising, however, that a large number of NZ troops are visiting the clubs of British and other organisations. This places an unfair burden on such voluntary organisations and it is felt that as NZ Forces Club is restricted to NZ troops, other clubs should be left free to offer maximum facilities to troops other than New Zealanders.
- (c) The necessity for rationing certain supplies such as beer, cigarettes, etc, results in NZ troops drawing more than their share at the expense of other troops, if they use the Clubs other than NZ Forces Club.
- (d) While it is not desired to place other Forces Clubs out of bounds, Coy Comdrs are requested to explain the position to the troops and to request them NOT to use Forces Clubs other than NZ Club unless invited to do so by troops of other forces.

BN LINES.

- (a) As "Ruapehu" personnel have departed from our midst - Coys will detail, on receiving instructions from Capt A Awatere to supply fatigues for the cleaning of areas when requested.
- (b) Sjt's Quarters: Remaining Sjts will arrange immediately for the cleaning of quarters vacated by "Ruapehu" Sjts and for the general tidiness of same forthwith.
- (c) Coy 2 i/c's will, after morning check parade, make a thorough inspection of Men's huts and lines and see that same are kept tidy and clean.
