- (a) Cases have been reported of Arabs accepting articles of clothing from troops in exchange for eggs and other foods.
- (b) With effect 28 Apr 43 any Arab found in possession of any article of BRITISH or DOMINION military clothing, or any article of military equipment, will be apprehended and sent onto 2 NZ DIV PSS.
- (c) Field Security Officers and W.D.L.Os. attached to formations of 10 Corps will ensure that this ORDER is fully understood by Arab Communities within the Corp Area. And that it is widely publicised.
