2. MOBILE DENTAL UNIT.

- (b) Coys will immediately prepare nominal roll (in duplicate) of all personnel for checking purpose and one copy to be handed to Dental Officer for cross checking.
- (c) Coy Comdrs will ensure that all personnel are dentally inspected.
- (d) Coys will parade personnel in Alphabetical order at Dental tent so as to expedite inspection and treatment of cases.
- (e) Routine of Attendance 13 May 43 at 0830 hrs B Coy.
Times for remaining Rifle Coys and Bn HQ and HQ Coy will be notified later.

3. CAPTURED ENEMY PERSONAL WEAPONS! Routine Order No 7 para 6 is hereby repeated.

- (a) All captured enemy personal weapons such as pistols and revolvers which have not been registered with ADCS will be collected and handed in to Bn HQ forthwith.
- (b) This order will be promulgated to all RANKS and severe disciplinary action will be taken against any soldier found in possession of unauthorised captured enemy weapons.
- (c) Coy Comds will ensure that all captured enemy personal weapons are collected and a return submitted to this HQ by 2000 hrs.
- (d) The above return to include all binoculars taken from the enemy.
