24. ROAD DISCIPLINE: Extract from 2 NZ Div. RO 149 dated 28 Nov. 42.  
"There has been a noticeable tendency towards slackness in the observation of traffic regulations particularly with regard to the over-taking of convoys and parking off the rd. TO will ensure that all drivers are conversant with all provisions regarding rd discipline and convoy regulations. It is once more notified that only STAFF CARS, Buses and Ambulance cars are permitted to over-take convoys on the move and that all vehicles must pull off the rd before stopping. In future disciplinary action will be taken against offenders".

25. PETROL WASTAGE:

Extract from 2 NZ Div. RO 149 dated 28 Nov. 42

(a) "It is evident that an excessive and unnecessary amount of petrol is used daily in sand fires for cooking. One often sees petrol being liberally poured into an open tin or even into a small hole in the sand, and a resulting fire which is far bigger than is necessary for the purpose. This practice should cease.

(b) "Such waste is wrong at any time. At the present moment, however, with an extended L of C and overcrowded rds, it is of operational importance to reduce petrol consumption to a minimum.

(c) "Whenever petrol cookers are available they will be used. Otherwise fires must be made, if possible from scrub, or in tins of a suitable size and with draft holes in which the minimum amount of petrol need be used.

(d) "The co-operation of all is requested to assist in the elimination of this waste of an essential war material".
