MENS MESSING

1. Two EPIP Tents are being erected adjacent to the two existing Mess Huts. These two tents will be used solely by HQ Coy personnel, and H.Q Coy will arrange to supply four additional Mess Orderlies for each meal.
2. The Eastern Mess Hut will be used solely by A and B Coys and the Western Mess Hut solely by C and D Coys.
3. Three separate queues will therefore be formed for each meal and the personnel will keep to their correct queue and use only the Mess Messing accommodation as set out under paras 1 and 2 above.
4. HQ Coy Mess Orderlies will be responsible for leaving their Mess Tents thoroughly clean after each meal.
5. Commencing Monday, 12 July; tea will be available in each Coys Mess Rooms from 0520 - 0540 hrs.
6. (a) Commencing Monday; 12 July, tea will be brought round to training areas for the 1015 - 1030 morning break ;
 (b) This is being tried out as an experiment and must not be allowed to interfere with training times as set out
 (c) The continuance of this practice will depend both on the tea ration allowing of it and on the time taken to deliver to Coy Areas ;
 (d) Men will include a mug in their haversack taken to training areas and on no account may men enter their huts or tents between 0900 - 1230 hrs.
 (e) TC will provide a truck which will reconnoitre Coy Areas before 1000 hrs, pick up tea containers from Mens Cook House at 1000 hrs and deliver to Coy Areas by 1015 hrs; Truck will then pick up empty containers at 1030 hrs and redeliver to Cook House by 1045 .
